Artwork Eligibility

Accepted media will include: Acrylic, Oil, Pastel, Tempera, Watercolor, Charcoal, Collage, China Painting, Mosaic, Pen & Ink, Pencil, Colored Pencil, Scratch Art, Leather Art, Pottery, Sculpture, Woodturning, and Woodcarving.

No prints of original artwork will be accepted. No photography, digital photography or fabric (textile) art will be accepted in this show (see future shows for these mediums).

Hanging artwork shall not exceed 24" x 30" total size (total 720 sq. inches—**this includes frame**) and shall not be smaller than 8" x 10". Three dimensional artwork (pottery, sculpture, wood carving, china painting, and wood turning) must not exceed 24" tall x 12" wide. You must list approximate size for each entry on registration form.

Please do not bring in oversized pieces as they will NOT be put on display.

Each hanging entry must be dry and suitably framed with hangers or it will not be hung. China painted plates will be accepted on plate stands or suitably framed for hanging. Final decision for hanging artwork will rest with the MAA check-in committee.

ALL ARTWORK MUST BE FOR SALE.

Entries are to be priced complete with frame and any attached hardware.

Your items will be insured for the sale price you list on your entry form less 20% MAA commission.

Entries:

Adult artists may submit a total of three (3) entries only.

Entries must not have been previously exhibited at any Mandan Art Show and must have been created within the last three years.

Receiving and Reclaiming Artwork

Artwork will be accepted from 12:00 noon to 6:00 PM on Saturday, March 31, at the MAA Gallery at 411 West Main.

Artwork will be displayed from April 2 through noon April 30h.

Artwork will be released to the owners beginning at noon on Tuesday, May 1, 2012. No early check out will be allowed except for those items purchased. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO PICK UP YOUR ARTWORK—WE DO NOT HAVE ROOM TO STORE ITEMS THAT ARE NOT PICKED UP.**

NO ARTWORK WILL BE RELEASED EARLY. Entries must be cleared with personnel prior to removal from the show. All numbers, tags and ribbons are to remain affixed to items for duration of show. Written permission allowing your artwork to be claimed by another party is requested. Buyers may remove their purchases at the time of purchase. The artist will then be allowed to substitute a replacement piece.
